4 measure Introduction.

Formation: Closed circle, joined hands held high with elbows straight.

Measure	Dance Pattern
1	Count 1, step on Right foot slightly to R. Count &, close Left to R, taking weight on L. Count 2, step on R ft in place. Count &, kick L heel in place.
2	Repeat Measure 1, with epposite footwork.
3	Repeat Measure 1.
4	Count 1, hold with weight on R ft. Count &, kick L heel in place. Count 2, stamp L ft in place and take weight on it. Count &, hold.
5	Count 1, step R with R ft. Count &, hold. Count 2, step L ft in back of R ft. Count &, hold.
Note:	Because of the tricky suncopation in Measure 14, it may be easier to count the whole dance as follows:
	1-2-3-kick, 1-2-3-kick, 1-2-3-kick, &-1-2-hold, R,L.
	Meas. 3 and 4 are syncepated in the rhythm of "shave and a hair cut - six bits."
