The Tuffields have got into the habit pf teaching their three great popular waltzes as a medley. This also makes a beautiful and popular exhibition.

To dance Jerry's Medley, simply dance each of these dances through once in the following order: Lovers' Waltz, - Honeymoon - Happy Waltz. At the end of each single sequence twirl and maneuver into position for the next dance. The music will tell you what to do. Instructions for Lovers' Waltz follow. Instructions for Honeymoon and Happy Waltz are on the accompanying page.

LOVERS' WALTZ

POSITION: closed with M's back to COH. FOOTWORK: Opposite throughout. Four measures of introduction: chhose your own acknowledgment.

MEASURES

1 - 4 SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE; FRONT, SIDE, BEHIND; BANJO AROUND, 2, 3; 4, 5, 6 Grapevine swd in LOD for 6 steps; in banjo pos (R hips adjacent), walk around for one full R or CW turn, to end again in closed position.

5-8 FRONT, SIDE, BEHIND; SIDE, FRONT, SIDE; BANJO AROUND, 2, 3; 4, 5, 63
Grapevine swd in RIOD starting with M stepping to R, crossing in front
with L (W crosses in back); repeat banjo; end in open pos, facing LODe

- 9 -12 STEP, SWING. -: CHANGE SIDES, 2, 3: CROSS, SWING, -: CROSS, TOUCH, Step on M's L, swinging R across; partners exchange positions, M crosses ing twd wall in front of W with 3 steps (R.L.R) turning R-face to face COH, while N crosses over twd center with 3 steps (L.R.L) turning L-face under her own and M's R hand (California twirl) to end in butterfly pos, M's back twd wall; M crosses L over R twd LOD and swings fwd in LOD while W crosses in front with her R and swings her L (note that both cross in front between self and partner); M steps across on R in front of L as he pivots L to face RLOD and touches L beside R. W crosses in front with L and pivots to face RLOD in open position;
- 13-16 STEP, SWING, -; CHANGE SIDES, 2, 3; CROSS, SWING, -; CROSS, TOUCH, -; Starting facing RLOD, repeat the action of meas 9-12 except that meas 15 finds partners shifting position with M facing LOD in butterfly pos; (The originators of the dance sanction either butterfly or loose closed position for meas 17-20).
- 17-20 TWINKLE (CROSS, STEP, STEP); TWINKLE, TWINKLE; STEP, TOUCH, -;
 (Monoves diagonally fwd in LOD, W bwd, M's foot crossed over in front on lst count of each meas, W's foot crossed in back) Cross L foot over R, step on R beside L, step on L beside R; cross R foot over L, step L beside R, step on R beside L; repeat meas 1; step on R, touch L;
- 21-24 DIP; R TURNING WALTZ; WALTZ: WALTZ:

 Bal bwd in RIOD on M's L and hold 2 counts; starting on M's R do 3

 meas of R-face turning waltz to end facing LOD; (optional twirl on m.24)
- 25-28 TWINKLE; TWINKLE; TWINKLE; STEP, TOUCH, -:
 Repeat action of meas 17-20.
- 29-32 DIP; R TURNING WALTZ; WALTZ; TWIRL; Repeat action of meas 21-24.
