FOOTWORK: - Opposite footwork, steps described for M.

INTRODUCTION MEAS.

1-4 WALK, 2: TWO-STEP: WALK, 2: TWO-STEP:

With M's back to COH, walk 2 steps fwd toward wall, LR; then two-

step (LRL) to left along LOD. Moving into COH(M going backwards)

2 steps RL, then two-step (RLR) along RLOD.

TWO-STEP TURN; TWO-STEP TURN;

Two clockwise turning two-steps ending with M's back to COH.

SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE, TOUCH; SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE, TOUCH;

M grapevines along LOD, side, behind, side, touch as W twirls

R-face under leading hands in 3 steps (RLR) and touches L to R.

Repeat action along RLOD with W making L-face twirl under M's R

and her L hands.

PART A

WALK, 2; PIVOT, 2, 3, -; WALK, 2; ROCK, 2, 3, -;

In semi-closed position walk fwd in LOD LR; then moving into closed position pivot one complete turn in 3 steps to end facing

LOD. Walk fwd RL; then rock fwd R, back on L, fwd R. TWO-STEP: TWO-STEP; TWO-STEP; TWO-STEP;

Four clockwise turning two-steps opening out on last two-step to face LOD.

REPEAT MEASURES 1-8.

PART B 17-18

SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE, BRUSH; SIDE, BEHIND, SIDE, TOUCH;

Move away from partner with a "grapevine" (twd COH for M) side, behind, side, brush; M repeats action twd partner as W twirls L-face in twd partner to end facing LOD.

19-20 STEP BRUSH, STEP BRUSH; STEP BRUSH; STEP BRUSH; In semi-closed position step L brush R fwd, step R brush L fwd; step L brush R fwd, step R brush L fwd.

REPEAT MEASURES 17-20 21-24

INTERLUDE:

TWO-STEP, STEP BACK; One two-step fwd in LOD (LRL) then step back in RLOD on R and touch L to R.

25-32 REPEAT MEASURES 1-8 ONLY OF PART A.

REPEAT ENTIRE DANCE STARTING WITH THE INTRODUCTION.
