

Mobile Apps Class Rules

Cafeteria / Hub breaks (PM class only)

We will have cafeteria breaks one or two times per week. Breaks are a privilege and must be earned. Breaks will be suspended due to disruptive behavior, vandalism, cheating, failure to follow instructions, and other rules violations. The break is part of the class curriculum and you will still be under examination from the instructor. The instructor will accompany the class to the break area. When the instructor gives the signal to return to class, please clean your area before you leave.

- Walk to the cafeteria quietly so we don't disturb other classes.
- Go through the line as soon as we get there. You may go through the line only once.
- You must stay inside the cafeteria at all times.
- It is your responsibility to watch for the teacher when it is time to leave.
- Leave your tables clean, and chairs pushed in.
- The administration will eliminate breaks if we do not keep the cafeteria clean.
- No food or drink is to leave the cafeteria.

Dress Requirements

Generally, students are expected to present themselves in a professional manner that employers expect to see in a model employee. The appropriate dress attire of a programmer is: Polo or button up shirt, casual slacks (Dockers), black or brown business style belt and comfortable dress shoes. Wearing pants below the waistline is not permitted.

- No clothes that are red or blue in color
- No clothes that show team/sport affiliations

Failure to comply with dress code policies or rules will affect your employability grade and could result in your expulsion from the school.

General Rules

You must be in your seat at the time the 12:30 pm bell rings to avoid being marked tardy. It takes some time for the computer to start up, so I expect you ready to do non-computer work immediately after the bell rings, and computer work about 5 minutes after that.

MP3 players and video games should not be brought to class. The school is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged property. Cell phones must be in your backpack at all times, or in a designated phone locker. You may use your cell phone only at break. If you fail to abide by this rule, your phone or mobile device can and will be confiscated. I can call security to have them confiscate your cell phone. Confiscated devices will only be returned to the parents at the Dean's office the next business day.

Because you will be using a computer throughout this course, you will be tempted to visit some of your favorite non-school related web sites, like Facebook and YouTube; this is not allowed in this class. You may visit YouTube only to watch videos that the instructor expressly assigns. Internet abuse will result in disciplinary action. You signed a form agreeing to the school's terms of computer and network use.

- No eating, gum chewing or drinking other than bottled water.
- Profanity and obscene gestures are offensive and unprofessional.
- Being disrespectful to fellow students, the teacher, or administrators.
- Failure to comply with instructions given by the teacher or administrators.
- Misuse of class equipment (including the computer use and network use agreement).
- Reading any materials in the classroom that do not pertain to the course. This includes YouTube, videos (unless assigned), using your phone, reading books, magazines, and other web sites not part of any assignment or assigned research.
- Cheating and forgery is not allowed and will always result in an F grade; a behavioral notice will be sent to your parents or guardian. You will not be allowed to make up the work.
- Every violation of these rules will also result in a notice going to your parents or guardian.
