

Assignment 4: College and Career Plans

Student learning outcomes:

1. Students will create organization in their web pages using H2 headers appropriately.
2. Students will create styles that make a document look like a piece of paper.
3. Students will think seriously about what career they might like to have, what college major might lead to that career, and which colleges have a program in that major area.
4. Students will exhibit information in which they have an investment: their college and career plans.

Real world applications:

1. Creating a page that has important information about oneself is the first step toward putting together a creative portfolio.
2. Employers will look more favorably on a potential employee that has ambition and is planning early.
3. The skills required to create this page could be used to create similar pages for others, including clients and employers.

Assignment requirements:

- The page will have two sections in this order:
 1. **Career goals.** This could include a fallback plan for if the economy changes in the next few years.
 2. **College plans.** This includes both a major and a choice of schools to apply to. This could also include a plan to attend community college if the plans are solid yet or if finances could be a problem.
- Each of the two sections will have an H2 heading, appropriately styled.
- The page will use typography that is suitable and readable.
- The page will use colors that are suitable and make the information easier to read.
- The page content will be contained in a DIV that has a background color, padding, and box shadow so it looks like a sheet of paper.
- The information should be typed up with absolutely perfect spelling, grammar, and punctuation. We intend it to be a document that shows off both web skills and English skills.
- The page will use styles such as font-size, font-style, max-width, and margin-top.
- The page will have P tags that have classes so we can style them distinctly as author and date.
