

## Writing Assignment 3: Web Site and App Ideas

Note: In the AM class, we will be making mostly Apps and not web sites, but if you have a good idea for a web site and you don't know how to make it, you could make a blog as an informational site, or you could learn to make web sites on your own time or after this class is over.

This assignment is to brainstorm what kind of apps we might make. Since we have not really learned anything yet, for the purposes of this assignment, we are not going to worry about whether the product is *feasible*. Any tech project may be infeasible for any of these reasons:

1. You don't know how to make it (yet)
2. It requires resources you don't have (money, time)
3. It requires expertise beyond what we are able to teach in a 36-week school year.

Just because a project is not feasible, does *not* mean that the project is *impossible*; actually, it is rare that any project is totally impossible. We just may not have the resources to do it at this time.

So, for this project, don't worry about whether the project is feasible or possible. Assume that we have the resources to make any app we want.

Your ideas should, however, fit this criterion: It has not been made yet (e.g. no music players, photo editors, messaging systems).

Write up these ideas on the computer and turn them in printed out on paper. Use one paper to turn them all in (not three separate pages). Each idea should ideally be only two or three sentences.



### 1. Your Dream App

If you could make any app or web site, what would it be? No limitations except that the app has not been made yet.

### 2. An app that will make you rich

If you could make an app or web site that would make you a million dollars, what would it be? No limitations except that the app functionality is not already available in the app store.

### 3. An app that will make the world a better place

What kind of app would actually benefit humankind, make the world a better place, or solve a long-standing problem that people face?
